
## Impact of COVID-19 in Rhode Island: Frontline Primary Care Provider Survey Results


### November 13 – 17th (Series 23) Key Messages

- Over half of RI providers that responded to the survey, reported that they were experiencing high to severe strain on their practice (69% compared to 56% Nationally)
- Stressors: In the past 4 weeks, RI providers responded to the survey that
  - Mental health of patients has worsened during the pandemic (93%)
  - We have staff out due to illness/self-quarantine (60%)
  - Practice members are experiencing health issues related to excess stress and fatigue (52%)
- Telehealth is being used for visits with patients who have stable chronic conditions (71%) and for mental or behavioral health counseling (69%)
- Providers are noticing among their patients
  - Higher levels of mental health concerns (90%)
  - More involvement in providing mental health support (76%)
  - Higher levels of unemployment among patients (67%)
- oRI Provider Comment: "Patients are refusing the flu vaccine because of increased mistrust."


# STRESSORS. Over the last 4 weeks, which of these things are true for your practice?




## WHERE IS CARE DELIVERY HAPPENING. Over the past 4 weeks, how would you characterize the modes of care delivered?




### SUPPLY CHAIN. Over the past 4 weeks, which of the following are true?




### INFO-DEMIC. Over the past 4 weeks, which of the following are true?




# SOCIAL DRIVERS OF HEALTH. Over the past 4 weeks, what have you noticed among your patients and have you been able to respond? We've...




#### **HOW IS PRACTICE STABILITY?**
