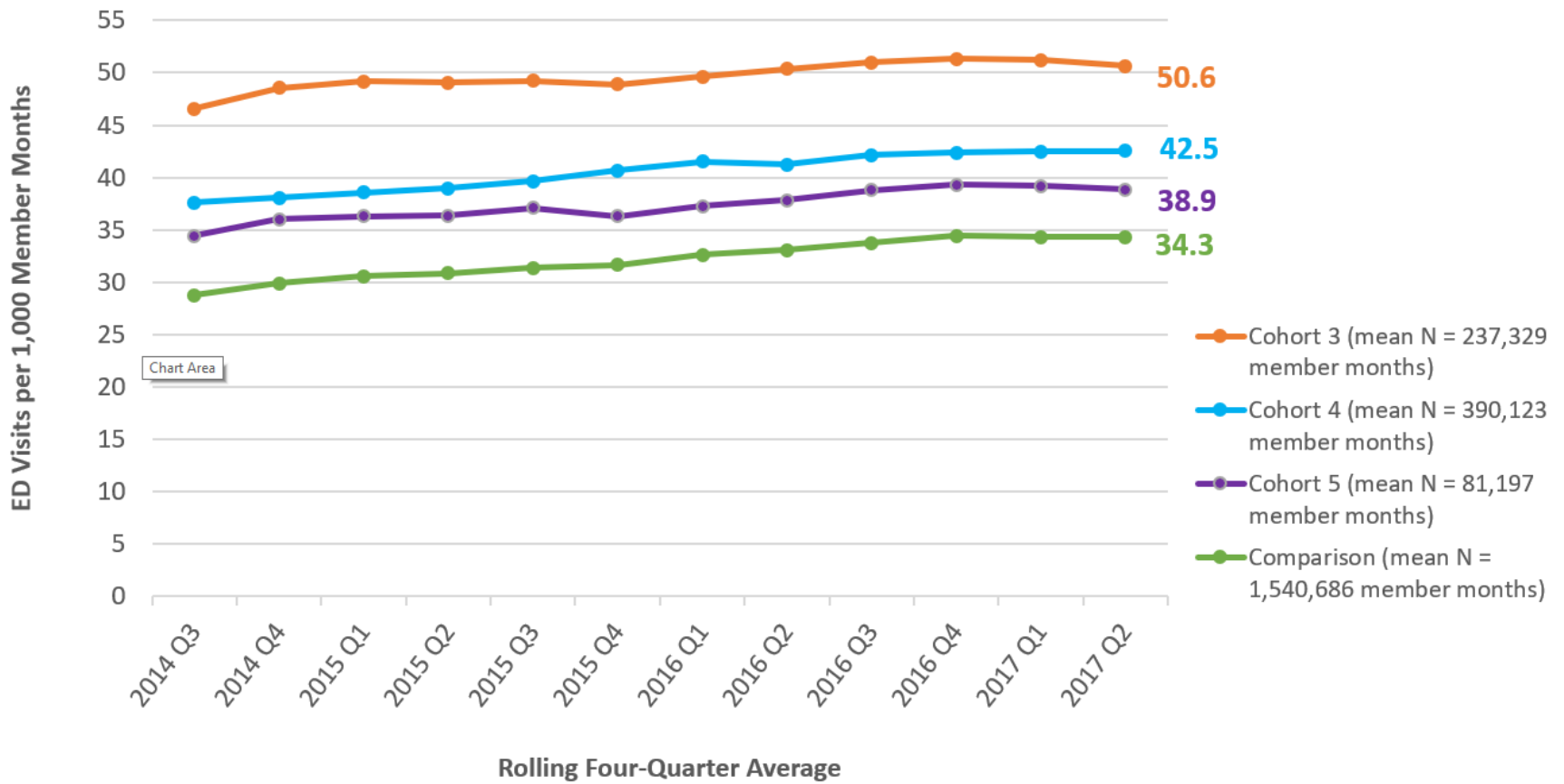

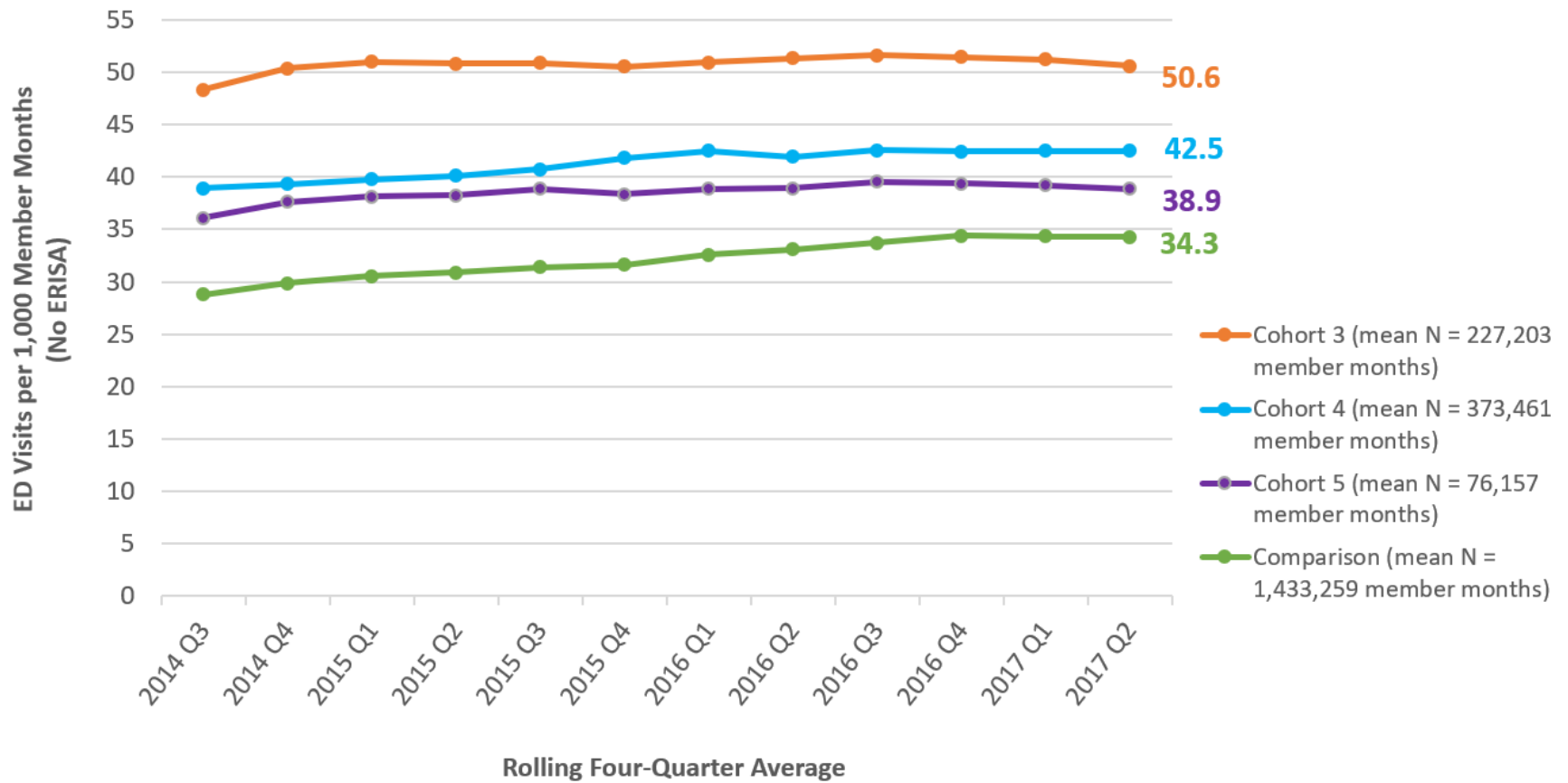
ED Visit Rate

Adults, Including ERISA Members



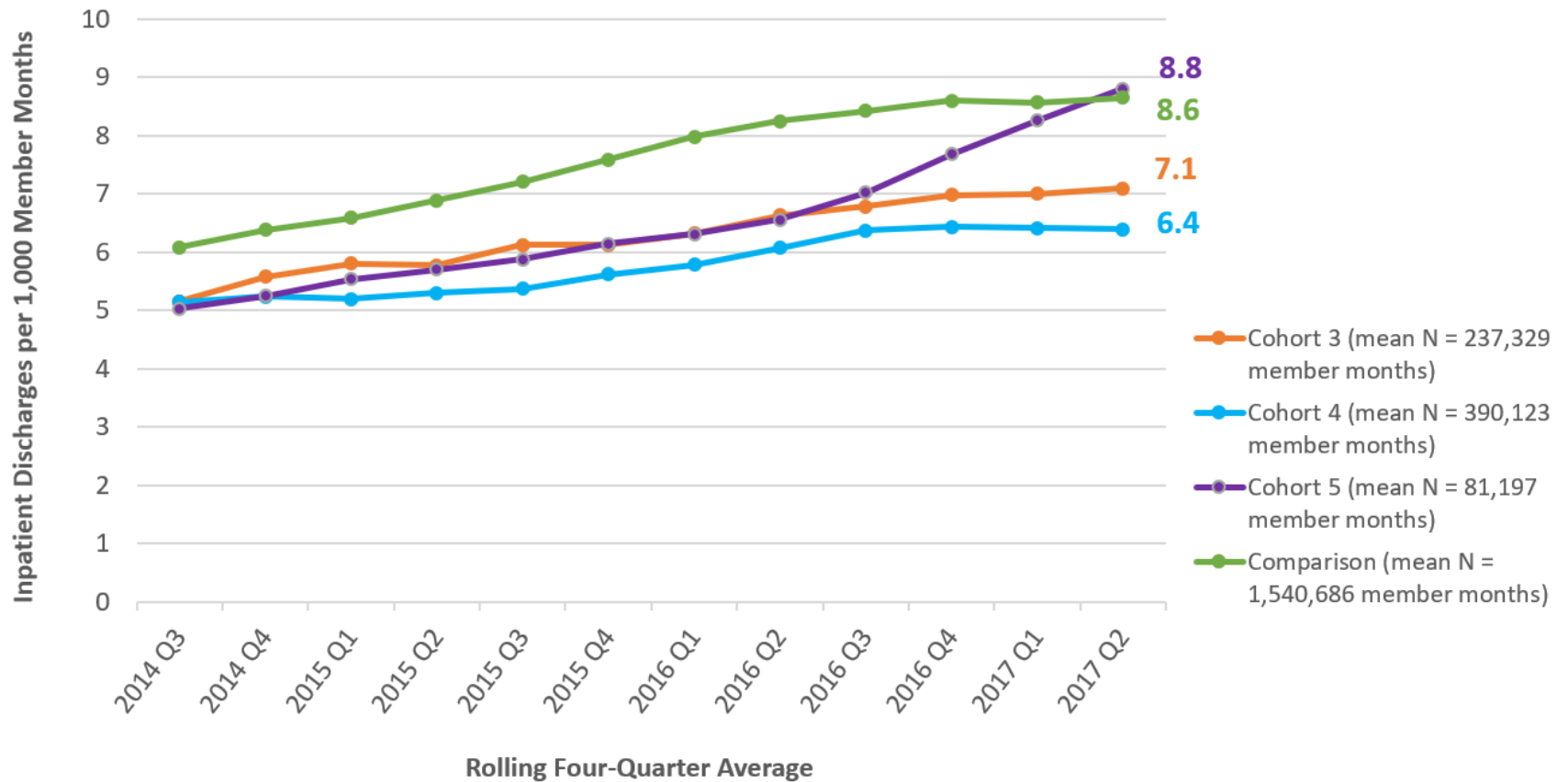
ED Visit Rate
